Parsonage Sale

Our Buyer has signed the agreement with the new closing date and deposit clause as agreed upon at MMfB. Their preliminary meeting with the Planning Board is actually next week – on July 30th. Both Ellie and Deana went this past week; they plan on being on Tuesday. In the meantime, Ellie is showing the property to 2 other motivated buyers. This will give us good back up, though she feels the current Buyer is going to come through in the end.

The Well

I contacted American Well regarding Analytical Balance's test showing Coliform in the water. Holly, American Well's office manager, dropped off a treatment kit at no charge on Tuesday. Buddy helped me "do it" on Thursday afternoon. We likely overdid it, but the instructions assured us it was better to over than under treat it. I ran the water for 45 minutes early Friday morning to flush the chlorine (starting with the outside hose to avoid as much chlorine as possible from going into the septic system). However, the water continued to be a brown color. Everyone assures me that we just need to run the water more, but this condition continues to unnerve me. We can have the water retested in 2-3 weeks.

Property Rentals and Use

Summer on Stage left a tub of lost and found on the back deck so that parents can stop by and retrieve items. I gave them the okay to store a mirror and a clothing rack in the basement until next summer. They hope to return next year, though the need for air conditioning on performance nights may affect this.

The Westport River Gardeners are requesting a meeting in August to make clear plans for next year. Their current president reported that having their plant sale on Memorial Day weekend instead of their traditional week earlier in May (the Young Friends held a retreat here) caused them to have their most successful plant sale ever -- and they want to do it on Memorial Day again next year. Since Property Committee is not yet activated, I am wondering if someone from MMfB or the mostly defunct FIR would be interested in trying to meet with the Gardening Club and me, just so there was another Friend present.
