Parsonage Sale

The parsonage did, indeed sell on Friday, September 6, 2013. The buyer sincerely shared her love for the property and her intention to honor the history and the spirit of the building. Due to our Tax ID, the check for the sale of the parsonage had to be made payable to NEYM. We will receive the check from NEYM next Wednesday (9/25) when I am in Worcester.

For many, many years, Meeting has been renting a Conversion Burner from New England Gas Company for the furnace in the parsonage. We alerted the buyer to this before the closing. Her heating contractor found no evidence of this equipment on the current furnace. I am trying to solve this mystery, wondering if it was on the previous furnace. I would welcome any information or suggestions Friends might have around this!

The Well

I have not heard back regarding the last water test, which means it must have been clear of bacteria, etc. I will contact the company on Monday and get the documentation needed to inform the Westport Health Department. It looks like the landscaping company recently seeded the area. We need to mark the well cap before winter so that the plow doesn't mistakenly run over it with a stone, a shrub, or a fence.
